We protect our open spaces before they are gone forever. This means preserving the unique ecology of this area. But it also means new nature trails you can hike with friends and family. It means ensuring our Lake Michigan waters are clean and safe. It means family farms protected forever for raising fresh, local food—a hugely important part of our economy. It means treasured land near the lakefront that will never be developed. It means making certain that our corner of Southwest Michigan retains the beautiful natural character that makes it a great place for all to live, work and play.
